An interfaith delegation is traveling to Minnesota next weekend, June 5–8, for the <u>Treaty People Gathering</u> to stop the Line 3 pipeline that crosses Anishinaabe land and would transport tar sands to market. Line 3 would violate Indigenous treaty rights. It would also carry 700,000 barrels of tar sands oil from Canada each day. It would have a climate impact on par with Keystone, and pose an existential threat to waterways like the Mississippi.
